We are so blessed to have clients taking our **Earn While You Learn** (EWYL) curriculum in 2019 – we have the Main Curriculum Module Pack which includes DVD lessons informing our clients on what to expect during each trimester of their pregnancy, and, also what is happening with the development of their baby and preparing for the birth and infant care. We also have Toddler and Parenting Pack modules which covers parenting children from ages 1 to 3 for the toddlers and ages 2 through 12 for parenting. Each lesson in the modules has a DVD worksheet and homework to help the clients to retain and remember the lessons. For every DVD lesson the client can earn points towards acquiring baby items.

We have several clients that take our EWYL DVD classes. They have indicated that they find that the information in the DVD's very helpful during their pregnancies and also when they have their babies or have young children. They like earning points towards earning baby items of their choice – some of the items that have been earned are baby bathtubs, bouncers, strollers, pack & plays, and high chairs.

We are hoping that even more clients will be interested in taking our classes this year and if you are interested in donating a brand new or gently used item such as a stroller, high chair, baby swing or pack & play or other similar things for our clients, please contact the Pregnancy Center at 751-2229.
